

ENLISTMENT REGULATIONS

What To Bring:

Bible, pen, sleeping bag/sheets/blankets and pillow, warm sweater/jacket, toiletries, towel, camera, medication, flash lights, baseball glove, {see standards and guidelines for specific dress codes): swim-suit, sport clothes for activities, appropriate clothes for church services, dress clothes for ministry specials, spending money for the snack shack, gym shoes, water shoes and clothes you don't mind getting 'messy'. (Cell phones/tablets/apple watches (or like) etc. cannot be used for alarm clock and/or camera!)

<u>Do Not Bring</u>: (counselors may bring their cell phones)

Guns, Fireworks, Tobacco, Alcoholic Beverages, Energy and coffee drinks, Drugs, radios, CD players, etc., cell phones, electronic games, computer, ipad, tablets, internet accessible devices, etc., ear buds, head phones, TV's, magazines, books, etc or T-shirts with worldly advertising (see standards and guidelines for more specific dress codes) If any prohibited or inappropriate items are brought to camp, they will be turned in to Camp Director, Pastor Ryan Guenther, for the remainder of the week.

Christian Conduct:

Fort Faith maintains a high standard of conduct and separation. The camp reserves the right to set standards of conduct such as male/female relations, dress standards, response to authority, etc. Campers who violate these standards are subject to dismissal at Parent's expense.

Please Note:

- 1. Campers are expected to stay the entire week except for sickness or emergency
- 2. Campers are not permitted to use a phone except in emergencies as deemed by the Pastor/Youth Pastor/Leader and will need to get permission from Camp Director, Pastor Ryan Guenther, and/or Camp Director Assistant, Kara Guenther.
